Art farm Marini

Art Farm - Agroktima Marini is a multifunctional Farm in Kalamata that promotes the agricultural legacy of Messinia. Their goal is to educate, inform and entertain the visitors in alternative ways! In 5.500m² Art Farm combines nature's uniqueness with human inspiration, providing an

experience to both adults and children. The Facilities include an amphitheatre, where cultural events are hosted during the summer season. The Main Building of 120m² is available for all kinds of seminars, feasts and social events. There are also five separate workshops, where agricultural

workshops take place.





Kalamata is the second most populous city of the Peloponnese peninsula, after Patras, in southern Greece and the largest city of the homonymous administrative region.

There are numerous historical

and cultural sights in Kalamata, such as the Villehardouin castle, the Ypapanti Byzantine church, the Kalograion monastery with its silk-weaving workshop where the Kalamata scarves are made, and the municipal railway

park. The Church of the Holy Apostles is where Mavromichalis declared the revolt against Ottoman rule in 1821. Local specialties: Kalamata olives and olive oil, Lalagia, Pasteli, Diples, Sfela and Feta Cheese.

Chlemoutsis remains "the most beautiful testimony of the military art in the Frankish principality", according to A. Bon

Chlemoutsis Castle

Chlemoutsis is a medieval castle in the northwest of the Elis regional Unit in the Peloponnese peninsula of southern Greece, in the Kastro-Kyllini municipality.

It was built in the early 1220s by the Crusader rulers of the Principality of Achaia as their main stronghold, and is perhaps the finest fortification of the early period of Frankish rule

in Greece preserved in the country today. The castle is located on a small plateau 226 metres (741 ft) above sea level, and comprises a central hexagonal keep, built around an inner courtyard and containing two-storeyed halls along its entire length, and complemented by an outer wall enclosing an outer yard on its western side. The castle is largely pre-

served in its original 13th-century state, with only minor later modifications for the installation of artillery.

Ancient Messini– Ancient Olympia

Ancient Messini



Ancient Messini was founded in 371 BC after the Theban general Epaminondas defeated Sparta at the Battle of Leuctra, freeing the Messinians from almost 350 years of Spartan rule. Built on the site of an earlier stronghold, the new Messinian capital was one of a string of defensive positions designed to keep watch over Sparta. Epaminondas himself helped to plan the fortifications, which were based on a massive wall that stretched 9km around the sur-

rounding ridges and completely enclosed the town.

Apart from its defensive potential, Ancient Messini was also favoured by the gods. According to local myth, Zeus was born here – not in Crete – and raised by the nymphs Neda and Ithomi, who bathed him in the same spring that gives the modern village its name.

Ancient Olympia

Located in the western Peloponnese, Olympia was an ancient Greek sanctuary site dedicated to the worship of Zeus in whose honour Pan-Hellenic Games were held every four years from 776 BCE to 393 CE. In Olympia, within the magnificent temple of the god, was the golden-ivory statue of Zeus, a work of Pheidias, which was known in

antiquity as one of the seven wonders of the world. In our days the ceremony of the Olympic Flame takes place before each Olympiad in the area of ancient Olympia and announces the opening of the Olympic Games.
